

Youth Protection Training

Thank you for agreeing to become a leader for the Boy Scouts. Please follow these steps to set up your MyScouting account and complete your Youth Protection training for the Boy Scouts of America. A completed training certificate will be required before you can register as an adult leader.

- Go to www.myscouting.org
- Click on “Create an account”
- Enter a User Name and Check User Name Availability
- If your User Name is available then click next
- Click on “I am new and don’t know my member ID”
- Click Next
- Enter your information that is required and then Create User
- Enter security questions
- Check your email account to complete account activation
- When you check your email then click on the link
- This will put you back into Myscouting.
- Create a New Password and then confirm it
- Once your password is accepted login to MyScouting.org
- Follow the instructions to take the Youth Protection Training
- Take the Course and print out your completion certificate

You can log back into your account through either of the 2 following websites
www.scouting.org or www.myscouting.org

You may also take other courses that will complete your training.

Once you are registered and know your Personal Identification Number (PID), you will want to add that to your account by updating your profile. Doing this will help link your training to your record at the Scout Service Center.
